

**RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE
GENERAL PURPOSE SCHOOL FUND BUDGET**

Resolution of the Obion County Board of Education to amend the General Purpose School Fund Budget for Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2009; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, the General Purpose School Fund Budget for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2009 was approved by the Obion County Board of Education on August 4, 2008 and by the Obion County Commission on August 18, 2008; and

WHEREAS, subsequently, the Alternative School teacher resigned and a replacement was transferred from the Special Education Program; and

WHEREAS, the new Alternative School teacher's degree and experience is greater than the teacher who resigned, thus causing a shortfall in the Alternative Education Program's salaries and benefits; and

WHEREAS, the General Purpose School Fund Budget must be amended to account for the above occurrence.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the respective legislative bodies of Obion County, Tennessee, meeting in regular session, amend the General Purpose School Fund as follows:
