DESTINATION: Cincinnati, Ohio

ELIGIBILITY:

Art Club requirements: Any Art Club member who is currently a senior or in Art 3 plus Art Club officers: This includes a total of 41 eligible students. We anticipate no more than 15-20. Requirements are as follows: Participants must:
