Lunch:

Meal Voucher Lunch:

- Georgia Aquarium offers meal vouchers for \$10 per person. Ask your sales manager about adding it to your reservation. Our meal voucher program allows you to have flexibility in the time you have lunch and it does not require that you reserve lunch seating.

Sack Lunch:

- We offer reserved lunch seating for up to 125 people with sack lunches.
- Groups with more than 125 people will not be permitted to reserve multiple lunch times.
- Students must be seated first.
- You are allotted 25 minutes to eat and five minutes to clean up. Groups should only arrive five minutes early.
- Georgia Aquarium lunch staff will transport lunches to the rotunda. School teachers must remove lunches from the bus.

students, and we will develop a "museum exhibit" to look at before our trip.

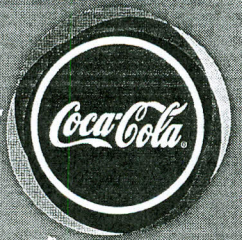

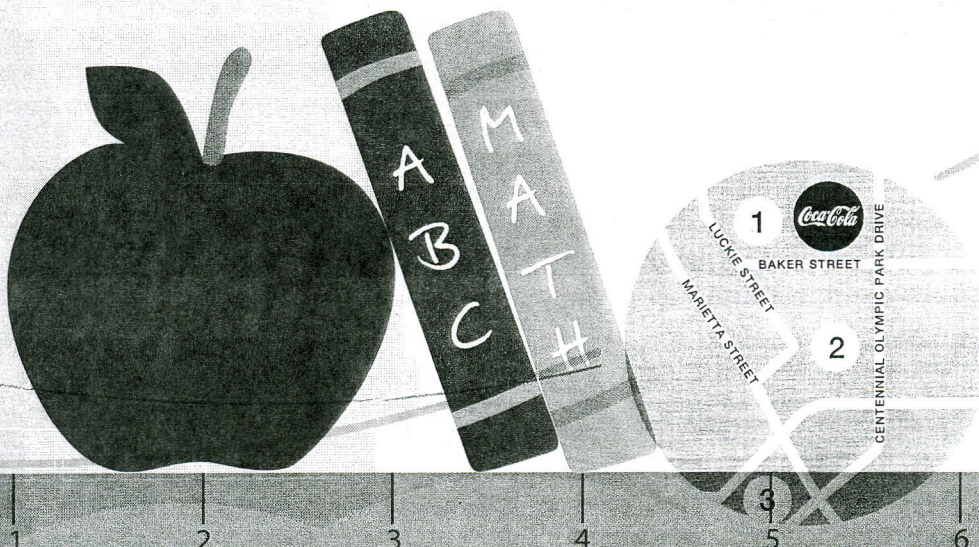

Education Program Descriptions

Aqua Adventures (\$11 per student) - Aqua Adventures is a self-guided tour for grades Pre-K to 12th on the main floor where you, the teacher, can take your student on a learning adventure through the Aquarium using the Aqua Adventure Learning Guides found on our web site. Downloadable guides are available for each grade level. Add-ons: 4D Theater - \$2.00 & Planet Shark -\$3.00

Instructor-Led Programs (\$12 per student) - Our exciting new hour long instructor-led programs allow for focused learning opportunities where students can expand their understanding of aquatic ecosystems. You may select from any one of the three programs available at each grade level. All programs are aligned to the Georgia Performance Standards (GPS) and include a downloadable Teacher Guide. To enhance your field trip experience, you are encouraged to spend the remainder of your time exploring the five galleries of the Georgia Aquarium. *Ticket includes Deepo's Undersea 4D Wondershow.*

Pre-Kindergarten (1:5 Chaperone comp ratio)

- Hide & Seek – Come and find what's hiding at the Georgia Aquarium. Students will explore the different places our animals call home and examine why and where they hide.
- Aqua Tales- Join Deepo, the Aquarium's mascot, on a wonderful storybook adventure! Students will explore how animals move and survive in their aquatic homes. Throughout the interactive program, students will discover the unique characteristics of some of our Aquarium friends.

Kindergarten to 2nd Grade (1:5 Chaperone comp ratio)

- Sea life Safari – Let's go on a safari! Throughout this program students will use their five senses to explore how animals thrive in their aquatic habitats. Students will discover how animals meet their basic needs while navigating through aquarium exhibits and our engaging learning stations.
- Bite-size Basics – All Animals have certain basic needs, including food. Come discover what some of our Aquarium residents eat, how they eat, and how their food is prepared.

3rd to 5th Grade (1:10 Chaperone comp ratio)

- Weird & Wild – Come along on a "weird & wild" adventure through the Georgia Aquarium! During this program, your students will explore some of our galleries to discover the "weird & wild" characteristics of our unique animals. The students will visit some behind-the-scenes areas while learning how these animals are able to survive in their unique habitats
- Snack Attack – Come explore some of the predator-prey relationships found in aquatic ecosystems around the globe. Discover how some of our amazing animals catch their meals – and how they keep from becoming a meal.

6th to 8th Grade (1:10 Chaperone comp ratio)

- Sharks In-Depth– There is much more to know about sharks than what we see on the surface. Acquire a deeper knowledge of sharks and how scientists learn about them. During this program, students will examine how sharks impact their environment and how humans impact sharks.
- Undersea Investigators (6th-8th) – Undersea Investigators is an inquiry-based program where students become researchers for the day. During this time, they will learn about aquatic animals and ecosystems through observation and collecting data. During the program, students will also be introduced to conservation efforts and research being conducted in partnership with the Georgia Aquarium.

9th to 12th Grade (1:10 Chaperone comp ratio)

- Aquarium 101 – Through an exploration of the Aquarium's exhibits and behind-the-scenes areas, students will be exposed to aquarium-related careers, research efforts, conservation programs and how the Aquarium meets the diverse needs of our animals.
- Animal Behavior – Before animals can live in an aquarium, biologists must understand what they need and how they behave. Students will discover how the Aquarium staff maintains the health of the animals and the training and enrichment techniques used in this process.

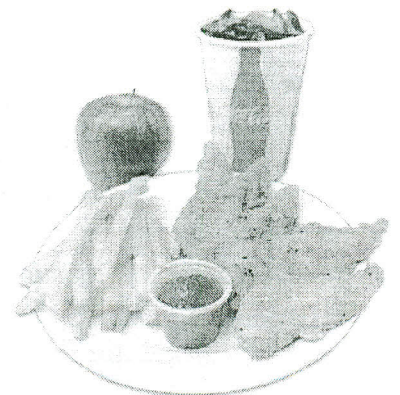
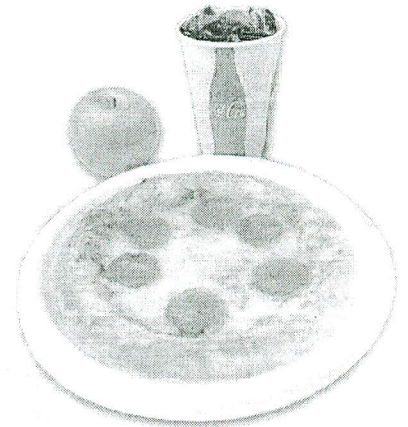
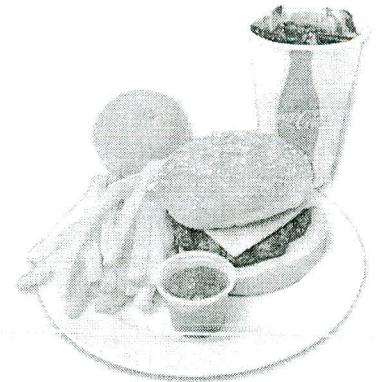
