1 No person shall, on the basis of sex, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, be
2 treated differently from another person or otherwise be discriminated against in any athletic program of
3 the school. Equal athletic opportunity shall be provided for members of both sexes.¹
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5 Interscholastic athletics shall be administered as a part of the regular school program and shall be the
6 principal's responsibility. Principals shall ensure that school regulations regarding participation in a
7 sport are reasonable. Athletic schedules shall be filed in each school principal's office. The principal
8 or his/her designee must accompany an athletic team on trips. Effective July 1, 2007, transportation of
9 teams to athletic games is approved by the Board, provided the team's school reimburses the Board for
10 the fee charged for payment of bus drivers. Procedures for paying such costs will be developed by the
11 director of schools.
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13 Bylaws of the Tennessee Secondary School Athletic Association shall regulate the operation and control
14 of secondary athletics. ²
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16 There shall be a complete annual physical examination of every student prior to his/her participation in
17 interscholastic athletics.³ Cost of the examination shall be borne by the parent or guardian of the student.
18 These records shall be on file in the principal's office. It shall be the responsibility of the parent(s) or
19 guardian to provide health and hospitalization insurance for all students participating in interscholastic
20 athletics.
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22 No principal or teacher of any school under the control of the Board shall dismiss his/her school or any
23 group of students for the purpose of permitting them to practice or play baseball, football, basketball
24 or any similar game within the regular school hours of any school day of the week without written
25 permission from the director of schools. This does not prevent the inclusion of regular physical training
26 lessons in the daily school program.⁴
