## RESOLUTION

Resolution of the Obion County Board of Education adopting subfund budgets for the School Federal Projects Fund as approved by the Tennessee Department of Education; and for other purposes.

- WHEREAS, the School Federal Projects Fund Budget for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2012 was approved by the Obion County Board of Education on June 27, 2011; and
- WHEREAS, although approved and adopted by the Obion County Board of Education, the State of Tennessee, as authorized by Federal Government, has final approval as to the various subfund budgets; and
- WHEREAS, the said budgets consist entirely of federal funds, which flow from the Federal Government through the State of Tennessee; and
- WHEREAS, it becomes an act of redundancy in having the Board approve a budget for which the governing body does not have the final approval.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of Obion County, Tennessee, meeting in regular session on this 5<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2011, that:
- SECTION 1. The Obion County Board of Education accepts, adopts, and declares that the Obion County School Federal Projects Fund for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2012 for the No Child Left Behind Act (NCLB), Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), Carl Perkins Vocational projects, 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Grant, and the State's First to the Top Act shall be the budget approved for the separate projects within the fund by the Tennessee Department of Education.
- SECTION 2. A copy of this *Resolution* shall be spread upon the minutes of the Board and transmitted to any interested individual or entity.

SECTION 3. This *Resolution* shall take effect upon adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
