South Fulton High/Middle School is submitting a request to the Board to declare surplus football uniforms that are no longer of any use to the School due to age. Furthermore, South Fulton requests permission to sell the uniforms and for the funds to be deposited to the restricted football account to help offset the cost of new uniforms. The value of the uniforms is less than the amount specified in TCA &49-6-2007 (d)(1), which provides, "Surplus personal property in local school systems which has no value or has a value less than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), may be disposed of without the necessity of bids as required by this section." Therefore, pending Board approval, no bids will be solicited to dispose of this personal property.
