The Obion County Board of Education met in regular session on February 4, 2013 at Hillcrest Elementary School. Mr. Northam seconded the motion. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Reconsider/Discuss Recommendation from the Athletic Advisory Committee

Concerning Middle School Football – Mr. Brian Moffitt presented a plan for Board

consideration to consolidate the Middle School Football Programs at Black Oak,

Hillcrest, Lake Road, and Ridgemont Elementary Schools. Under the proposed plan,

sixth grade participants would play in the Mud League; seventh grade students would compete with other seventh grade teams; and eighth grade students would compete with other eighth grade teams. A motion was made by Mr. Partin to approve the consolidated plan as presented and Ms. Sanderson seconded the motion. Board Chairman Rainey requested a roll call vote with Ms. Sanderson, Mr. Partin, Mr. Easley, Mr. Northam, and Mr. Rainey voting yes. Mr. Fussell and Mr. Lamb voted no. **MOTION CARRIED 5 – 2.**
