

**RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE
GENERAL PURPOSE SCHOOL FUND BUDGET**

Resolution of the Obion County Board of Education to amend the General Purpose School Fund Budget for Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2013; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, the General Purpose School Fund Budget for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2013 was approved by the Obion County Board of Education on August 6, 2012 and by the Obion County Commission on August 20, 2012; and

WHEREAS, subsequently, an Individualized Education Program (IEP) Team meeting was held to address special needs of a student; and

WHEREAS, the IEP Team recommended, and the School System agreed, to place this student in the student's least restrictive environment so that the student's needs could be met; and

WHEREAS, the IEP Team recommended, and the School System agreed, to pay the cost for the student's parents to visit the student twice monthly; and

WHEREAS, most, if not all, of the costs associated with this placement and travel will be reimbursed by the State of Tennessee; however, the School System must pay for these services in advance; and

WHEREAS, the General Purpose School Fund Budget must be amended to include said expenditures since all of these additional costs must be accounted for within the General Purpose School Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the respective legislative bodies of Obion County, Tennessee, meeting in regular session, amend the General Purpose School Fund as follows:
