We cordially invite your high school to participate in the 2014 Tennessee Science Bowl (TSB), sponsored by the U.S Department of Energy and administered by ORAU. The TSB team registration and dinner will be held on Friday, February 21, at the Hilton Knoxville Airport in Alcoa. The competition will begin promptly at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, February 22, at Pellissippi State Community College, Blount County Campus, in Friendsville, TN.

TEAM REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Online registration will open at noon EST on October 1, 2013.

Go to http://www.orau.gov/sciencebowi/teams/teams.html and click on the registration link to begin the registration process. The link will take you to the online Department of Energy (DOE) National Science Bowl® (NSB) registration site. All teams that plan to participate in the TSB must register at this site. There is no registration fee for teams to participate in the 2014 TSB.

Due to the growing number of teams that wish to participate, the following deadlines will be in effect and strictly enforced:

December 9:

Deadline for registering Team 1 (with names of all team members included)

December 16:

Deadline for receipt by ORAU of all required student and adult forms for *Team 1*, including NEW Code of Conduct and Second Coach/Chaperone Registration forms. Documentation from a school or district administrator is required for all school/district-required chaperones.

December 18:

Deadline for acceptance of first teams (contingent upon available space; acceptance of first

teams will be based on the date and time of registration). First come, first served!

December 20:

Deadline for registering Team 2 (with names of all team members included)

January 6:

Deadline for receipt by ORAU of all required student and adult forms for *Team 2*, including NEW Code of Conduct and Second Coach/Chaperone Registration forms. Documentation from a

school or district administrator is required for all school/district-required chaperones.

January 3:

Deadline for acceptance of second teams (contingent upon available space; acceptance of second teams will be based on the date and time of registration). First come, first served!

January 27:

Changes to team members must be finalized!! No changes will be made after this date unless due to an unforeseen emergency. Call Marolyn Randolph at 865-576-7560 to provide details.

All changes must be approved by the TSB Coordinator.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT NON-U.S. CITIZEN TEAM MEMBERS

Non-U.S. Citizen students may participate in the TBS; however, a non-U.S. Citizen student who is a member of a regional winning team must provide either a social security number or permanent resident number in order to participate in the final three rounds at the NSB. If the regional winning team advances to the final three rounds at the NSB and if any high-profile official such as the President of the United States, First Lady, Vice President or other high-ranking official attends, a non-U.S. Citizen student cannot compete in those final rounds, if a social security or permanent resident number is not provided. Furthermore, if a high-profile official attends the final rounds, the non-U.S. Citizen student cannot attend the NSB final rounds if s/he is from a terrorist country included on the U.S. Department of State's list found at http://www.state.gov/i/ct/list/c14151.htm.

LODGING

Lodging at the Hilton Knoxville Airport will be provided by ORAU for all participating team members. Four (4) students will be assigned to each room. One room for lodging will be provided for <u>one</u> primary coach per team (unless the second coach or chaperone, required by the school system, will room with the primary coach). Due to TSB budget limitations, each additional coach or chaperone (not rooming with the primary coach) must make his/her own lodging arrangements and cover the cost. The Hilton Knoxville Airport will provide the TSB room rate for individual reservations, if rooms are available. Please ask for Tiarra Giles or the Sales Office at 865-970-4300 to obtain the TSB room rate for individual reservations.

TRANSPORTATION

Mileage will be reimbursed at \$.565 per mile for one personal vehicle from your school to PSCC, Blount County, and return. If you need to rent a small van, the cost of the van and fuel for travel on February 21-22 will be reimbursed, with approval by the TSB Coordinator before February 21. Original receipts for the cost of the van and fuel must be submitted for reimbursement. Reimbursed is contingent on the availability of funds.

MEALS

Dinner on February 22 at the Hilton Knoxville Airport and lunch on February 23 at PSCC, Blount County Campus, will be provided to officially registered students, coaches, and chaperones required by a school or district.

TEAM REGISTRATION ON FEBRUARY 21

On February 21, team registration; lodging registration; team photos; drawings for team placements in the round-robin competition bracket; distribution of t-shirts and tote bags; social activities; dinner and guest speaker; drawings for door prizes; and a brief orientation will be held. These activities will take place at the Hilton Knoxville Airport in Alcoa, TN. All teams must register on Friday, February 21, even if a team does not intend to lodge at the Hilton. Team registration will not be conducted on Saturday, February 22, due to the 8:00 a.m. start of the competition.

COMPETITION AT PSCC, BLOUNT COUNTY CAMPUS ON FEBRUARY 22

On February 22, teams will arrive no later than 7:45 a.m. at Pellissippi State Community College's campus in Blount County (located about 8 miles from the Hilton Knoxville Alrport) to report to the competition rooms. The first round (round-robin format in the a.m.) will begin promptly at 8:00 a.m. Lunch will be provided to all officially registered students, coaches, and chaperones. The final sixteen teams will compete in a single-elimination format after lunch, and the championship round will and around 4:30 p.m.


PRIZES

Trophies and cash prizes will be awarded to the top four teams. The 1st place team will receive \$1,000. The 2nd place team will receive \$750; 3rd place will receive \$500; 4th place will receive \$250; and the Civility Award team will receive \$100. *The first-place team also earns a trip to Washington, D.C., all expenses paid, to represent Tennessee at the National Science Bowl on April 24 - 28.*

Regional Science Bowl Code of Conduct

Team members, including coaches, must conduct themselves professionally and in a manner that will bring honor to them, their school, and the competition.

- Possession or use of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs is prohibited.
- · Smoking or using other tobacco products is prohibited in all buildings.
- Shirts and shoes are required inside all buildings at all times.
- Participants and coaches must respect personal and public property. Repair costs for damages incurred
 to property will be billed to the school responsible for such damages.

The use of electronic devices (cell phones, MP3 players, iPads/tablets, etc.) is not permitted in any competition room. If a staff member or an official sees a participant using these devices in a competition room, the device will be removed from the individual and returned at the conclusion of the event.

This is a team event, therefore one team member, coach, or team supporter, by his or her conduct, could jeopardize the entire team. If officials consider any behavior to be unsportsmanlike, such as questioning the judgment of officials, this will result in the team's disqualification from the tournament.

I have read and will abide by the Tennessee High School Regional Science Bowl Code of Conduct. Failure to completely adhere to the items above will result in the disqualification and expulsion of the team for the 2014 competition and may result in the disqualification of the school for the 2015 Regional Event.
