- The Board shall provide for a system-wide testing program which shall be periodically reviewed and evaluated. The purposes of the program shall be to:
- Assist in promoting accountability;
- 4 2. Determine the progress of students;
- 5 3. Assess the effectiveness of the instructional program and student learning;
- 4. Aid in counseling and guiding students in planning future education and other endeavors;
- 5. Analyze the improvements needed in a given instructional area;
- 8 6. Assist in the screening of students with learning difficulties;^{1,2}
- 7. Assist in placing students in remedial programs;
- 10 8. Provide information for college entrance and placement; and
- 9. Assist in educational research by providing data.
- The director of schools shall be responsible for planning and implementing the program, which
- includes:
- 1. Determining specific purposes for each test;
- 2. Selecting the appropriate test to be given;
- 3. Establishing procedures for administering the tests;
- 4. Making provision for interpreting and disseminating the results;
- 18 5. Maintaining testing information in a consistent and confidential manner; and
- 6. Ensuring that results are obtained as quickly as possible, especially when placement in a special learning program might be necessary.
- State-mandated student testing programs shall be undertaken in accordance with procedures published
- by the State Department of Education.³

- Student scores on the Tennessee Comprehensive Assessment Program's grades three through eight (3-1
- 8) shall comprise fifteen (15%) percent of the student's final grade in the spring semester in the subject 2
- areas of mathematics, reading/language arts, science and social studies.4 3
- Any test directly concerned with measuring student ability or achievement through individual or group 4
- psychological or socio-metric tests shall not be administered by or with the knowledge of any 5
- employee of the system without first obtaining written consent of the parents or guardians.² 6
- Results of all group tests shall be recorded on the students' permanent records and shall be made 7
- available to appropriate personnel in accordance with established procedures.⁵ 8
- No later than July 31 of each year, the Board shall publish on its website information related to state 9
- and board mandated tests that will be administered during the school year. The information shall 10
- include: 6 11
- 1. The name of the test; 12
- 2. The purpose and use of the test; 13
- 14 3. The grade or class in which the test will be administered;
- 4. The tentative date or dates that the test will be administered; and 15
- 5. The time and manner in which parents and students will be notified of the results of the test. 16
- Beginning with the 2015-2016 school year and for school years thereafter, the testing information shall 17
- also be placed in student handbooks or other school publications that are provided to parents on an 18
- annual basis. 19
