- 1 A Disciplinary Hearing Authority (DHA) shall conduct appeals for students who have been suspended for more
- than ten (10) school days. The Board shall appoint members to the DHA which shall consist of three (3) 2
- members, (maximum number must not exceed total membership of Board) at least one (1) of whom shall be a 3
- 4 licensed employee of the board, and such appointments are for one (1) year terms and subject to reappointment.
- Board members shall not serve on the DHA. 5

- 6 The director of schools shall appoint a chairman of the DHA from the members appointed by the Board. The chairman shall perform the following duties: 7
- 8 1. Set the time, place and date for each hearing;
- 9 2. Maintain order and structure during each hearing; and
- 3. Prepare, sign, and disseminate the minutes of each meeting. 10
- The DHA may take the following disciplinary actions: ² 11
- 1. Affirm the decision of the school principal; 12
- 13 2. Order removal of the suspension unconditionally;
 - 3. Order removal of the suspension upon such terms and conditions as it deems reasonable; or
- 15 4. Suspend the student for a specified period of time.*
- The notice of the hearing shall include a statement that, unless the student's parent or guardian requests an open 16
- hearing in writing within five (5) days of receipt of the notice, the hearing shall be closed to the public.³ 17
- 18 * Note: Zero-tolerance offenses as set forth in statute require mandatory calendar year expulsion or assignment
- 19 to alternative placement for a calendar year unless modified by the director of schools.
