WHEREAS, the Obion County School System had water damage to the gym floor at Black Oak Elementary and damage at Obion County Central High School due to water lines bursting; and

WHEREAS, this damage was unforeseen; and

WHEREAS, we will be receiving insurance recovery from Tennessee Risk Management Trust;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the respective legislative bodies of Obion County, Tennessee, meeting in regular session, amend the General Purpose School Fund as follows:

Resolution of the Obion County Board of Education to amend the General Purpose School Fund Budget for Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2016; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, the General Purpose School Fund Budget for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2016 was approved by the Obion County Board of Education on July 14, 2015 and by the Obion County Commission on August 10, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Obion County School System receives a federally funded grant for Special Education (IDEA PART B); and

WHEREAS, teacher salaries, educational assistant salaries, bus driver salaries, assessment personnel salaries, instructional supplies and contracted services with private and public agencies for special needs students are budgeted in IDEA PART B; and

WHEREAS, IDEA PART B funds have been reduced by the State Department of Education for several years but need for services have increased; and

WHEREAS, there is a shortage of funds available in this program and the salary of one teacher needs to be transferred into the General Purpose Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the respective legislative bodies of Obion County, Tennessee, meeting in regular session, amend the General Purpose School Fund as follows:
