We would like to install a batting cage outside the outfield fence behind the scoreboard. The cage will be placed a minimum of fifteen feet away from fence and any other structure to allow for mowing and equipment access. The batting cage will be 11 feet high x 11 feet wide x 55 feet long. The cage will be installed using eight 4x4x15 post set in concrete, topped with 3" angle iron to secure and steady post. The cage will be suspended using eye bolts, vinyl coated airplane cable, thimbles and clamps. The cage will be hung on the reinforcement braided rope throughout the cage. We will also install $\frac{3}{4}$ inch pvc pipe in the bottom of the net so the net can be hung on J hooks for mowing around the net. I would like to use the allocated money allowed for softball to purchase the materials used to build the structure. The net will be purchased using money from softballs restricted account, which is money raised through our play day and signs. All labor will be donated to the school.
