Maintaining Test Security

Annually, the Board of Education will designate a system testing coordinator who shall be responsible for administering, monitoring and maintaining security of all tests to be administered within the school system. The principal of each school shall serve as or designate a building testing coordinator who shall be responsible for the administrating, monitoring and maintaining security of all tests given in his/her school. Test security procedures shall adhere to guidelines issued by the State Department of Education.¹

Testing coordinators, test administrators and proctors shall be required to sign a statement that the security measures and testing procedures were followed. 2

The director of schools shall report within 24 hours a breach of security to the State Department of Education Office of Accountability and any testing irregularity to the Division of State Testing. In any class, grade, and/or school where a security breach is strongly suspected or verified, central office staff will be present during subsequent administration of tests for a period of two years.
